This program is designed to work with young parents at-risk through group work, home visits, referrals and advocacy. The supervisor of the program is responsible for the development, implementation and facilitation of a program for young parents and their children. In addition, you will directly supervise four childcare staff members. In a typical week you will facilitate two groups and oversee an afternoon playschool once per week. The rest of your time will be used for planning and connecting with clients one to one.

What you will need:

A minimum of four years combined education and experience in human services. A minimum of 2 years facilitation experience. A minimum of 1 year supervision experience. Experience with program planning development, delivery and evaluation. Experience working with at-risk youth. A valid drivers license.

Who you are:

You have an understanding of theory and practice of counseling models, crisis management, problem solving, early childhood development, bonding and attachment, and the needs of young parents. You must have good written and oral communication skills. You are organized, enjoy working with a team, and are able to work flexible hours.
